NAP definitions

LIFE: First-year paid annualized modal premium (i.e., minimum premium), plus any pour-in premium up to commission target premium on external 1035 exchange money

SUPPLEMENTAL HEALTH: First-year paid annualized modal premium minus not-takens

FIXED ANNUITY: First-year plus subsequent rollovers, transfers or exchanges
